Job Summary

The Journeyman Roofer is a skilled tradesperson who has successfully completed a two-year roofing apprenticeship. This position is responsible for independently performing roofing installations, repairs, and maintenance on a variety of roofing systems. The Journeyman Roofer ensures quality workmanship, safety compliance, and may assist in mentoring apprentices.

Essential Duties

- Install and repair commercial and residential roofing systems with minimal supervision
- Interpret blueprints, specifications, and manufacturer instructions
- Inspect completed work for quality assurance and ensure compliance with safety regulations
- Mentor and provide hands-on training to Apprentice Roofers
- Operate and maintain tools, equipment, and machinery safely and efficiently
- Diagnose and troubleshoot roof issues and recommend solutions
- Coordinate with team members and supervisors to meet project timelines

Secondary Duties

- Participate in safety meetings and ongoing skills training
- Provide feedback to supervisors on project progress and crew performance
- Assist in estimating material needs and inventory control
- Help lead small crews as needed on job sites

Supervisory Responsibilities

Education

A high school diploma (or GED or high school equivalence certificate) is preferred.

Behavioral Characteristics

- Initiative -- Job requires a willingness to take on responsibilities and challenges.
- Leadership -- Job requires a willingness to lead, take charge, and offer opinions and direction.

- Cooperation -- Job requires being pleasant with others on the job and displaying a good-natured, cooperative attitude.
- Dependability -- Job requires being reliable, responsible, and dependable, and fulfilling obligations.
- Attention to Detail -- Job requires being careful about detail and thorough in completing work tasks.
- Independence -- Job requires developing one's own ways of doing things, guiding oneself with little or no supervision, and depending on oneself to get things done.

Language Skills

- Oral Comprehension -- The ability to listen to and understand information and ideas presented through spoken words and sentences.
- Written Comprehension -- The ability to read and understand information and ideas presented in writing.
- Oral Expression -- The ability to communicate information and ideas in speaking so others will understand.
- Written Expression -- The ability to communicate information and ideas in writing so others will understand.
- Active Listening -- Giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times.

Reasoning Ability

- Problem Sensitivity -- The ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem, only recognizing there is a problem.
- Spatial Orientation -- The ability to know your location in relation to the environment or to know where other objects are in relation to you.
- Troubleshooting -- Determining causes of operating errors and deciding what to do about it.
