Job Summary

The Master Control Operator is responsible for the preparation, screening, and quality control of the Company's cable transmission and social media streaming.

Essential Duties

- Monitor and ensure the integrity of scheduled and live programming, adjusts schedule using program filler effectively as needed
- Monitor and perform basic troubleshooting for Hawaiian Telcom and Spectrum cable channels, VOD channels, online distribution outlets, and outer island feeds; also performs routine testing and drills for situation such as power outages or natural disasters.
- Encodes, quality check, and activate files prior to being put on air.
- Works closely with internal departments to ensure the highest quality experience of Olelo's linear, VOD, online and live content to viewers.
- Manage and monitor multiple simultaneous live feeds including via remote cellular HD backpack systems
- Perform emergency equipment checks in the event of a power outage or other natural disaster to maintain our ability to distribute content
- Troubleshoot, document, report, and communicate problems and/or tasks to immediate supervisor on a regular basis
- Performing building security checks at end of day to lock the building and enable security alarm as needed.
- Assist in training new hires as needed
- Building on-air logs, prepare programs for on-air playback & VOD system.
