Job Summary

Prepare cut fish and seafood items as value added products (sashimi, poke, smoked fish). Mix and prepare sauces. Pack products in boxes for shipment

Essential Duties

- Prepare, mix and dispense ingredients for sauces
- Prepare, label and pack sashimi trays, poke kits and smoked product
- Issue and barcode ingredients and products
- Clean area throughout shift and sanitize at end of day as required

Secondary Duties

- Clean common areas on scheduled rotation (break room, bathroom)

Supervisory Responsibilities

This job has no supervisory responsibilities.

Education

This position requires a high school diploma (or GED or high school equivalence certificate) and 1 year to 2 years of previous experience.

Behavioral Characteristics

- Must be able to follow all procedures and protocols (SOPs) related to essential duties including the safe and sanitary handling of food and food-related supplies.
